The Naval Aviation Systems TEAM has completed the evaluation of technology projects presented at the Carrier Advanced Technology Review Board (CATRB) held at Patuxent River, Maryland on 9 and 23 June 2004. Twelve technology initiatives were evaluated by two program offices The Air Traffic Control, PMA-213 and Aircraft Launch & Recovery System, PMA-251 and representatives from the Chief of Naval Operations (N78). Enclosure (1) provides the ratings assigned during that process. Specific comments from the decision meeting relating to the non-proprietary technology projects are provided in enclosure (2). Enclosure (3) provides a blank Technology Transition Agreement (TTA) for use at the PMAs' discretion.

2. We commend the sponsoring commands and industrial partners for their participation in the process and for the quality of the technology programs presented. We encourage continued funding and transition planning for those initiatives listing Program Manager "Support" and "Endorsement" from this CATRB.

3. The interchange from this CATRB meeting was very productive and the results are provided to further assist in technology focus and transition planning. We plan to invite Aircraft Carriers Program, PMS-312 and Future Carriers Program, PMS-378 as voting members at the next CATRB.
